**RULES FOR THE DRAW TO BENEFIT OPÉRATION ENFANT SOLEIL**

**The holder of the winning ticket** will win a prize worth \$500,000 (with taxes) including the house, furniture, all appliances, decoration and an allowance of \$100,000 for a lot and landscaping.\* Notary fees, the certificate of location, the layout plan, the construction permit and the land transfer tax are the winner's responsibility.

The winner has the choice between a prize worth \$500,000 (taxes included) or \$325,000 in cash. The prize drawing will take place on August 9, 2018, between 6 and 9 a.m., on TVA's "Salut Bonjour".

Tickets for this draw cost \$10. They are numbered from 000 001 to 330,000. The sale of these tickets is only authorized inside the province of Quebec to persons aged 18 and older.

The winner must present the winning ticket and claim the prize within 30 calendar days of the draw at the head office of Opération Enfant Soleil, which is located at 450 Saint-Jean-Baptiste Avenue, Suite 10, Quebec City, Quebec G2E 6H5 (phone number: **1-877-683-2325**). A maximum of four (4) months will be granted to Bonneville Homes to deliver the house. Bonneville Homes will have a period of six (6) months to finish work on-site after delivery of the house. The house can be delivered between September 1, 2018, and May 15, 2019. The foundation and the excavation of the lot cannot be performed from November 1 to April 1 due to the frost period. If the winner chooses the prize money, \$325,000 in cash will be given to him or her no later than 60 calendar days after it is claimed.

The actual house could differ from the picture printed on your ticket.

The rights for the distribution and sale of the 330,000 tickets intended for this draw are exclusively limited to the personnel and individuals authorized by Opération Enfant Soleil.

*\* In the event that the installation and finishing of the house take place more than 250 km from the city of Beloeil, \$150 per kilometre will have to be paid by the winner. In addition, the selected lot must receive public utility and municipal services (electricity, water, etc.). The lot must be easily accessible to trucks carrying the modules, using a Transports Québec-approved roadway. If the lot requires the use of a crane, the costs incurred will be borne by the winner. The house comes with an unfinished basement on a concrete slab, which does not include divisions, gypsum, siding or electricity. Two standard windows are included. **EXCLUSIONS:** Well, septic tank and disposal field, grading, site fill, blasting, exceptional excavation and landscaping and all expenses incurred due to soil composition (equipment, work or special expertise); drainage other than around the foundation, such as drainage from the foundation to the ditch; all transport (additional earth, snow, etc.) and loading of material on another site; additional support for unstable ground; and any other event deemed uncontrollable by Bonneville.*
