The holder of the first ticket drawn will win a prize, hereafter referred to as the “Grand Prize” valued at more than \$500,000, taxes included, that is composed of the following: the house, furniture, all appliances, decor and \$100,000 in funds for the lot and landscaping. \*Notary fees, the certificate of location, the layout plan, the construction permit and the land transfer tax are the winner’s responsibility.

The “Grand Prize” winner can choose between a prize valued at more than \$500,000, taxes included, or \$325,000 in cash.

### Secondary Prizes

### Participation in the Draw and Prize Claim

The draw for the “Grand Prize” will take place on July 16, 2020, between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m. on the *Salut Bonjour* program on TVA. The draw of the 33 secondary prizes will follow off-air between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. The entire draw will be filmed and posted the same day no later than 2 p.m. on the Opération Enfant Soleil Facebook page. All winners will be notified by phone on the day of the draw or the following days if they were absent at the time of the first phone call. An email stating that they are the winners will be sent to them within 24 hours of the draw. The list of all the winners will be published after the draw no later than 2 p.m. on the website [www.maisonenfantsoleil.ca](http://www.maisonenfantsoleil.ca), in the Journal de Québec, in the Journal de Montréal and on the Opération Enfant Soleil Facebook page.

Tickets for this draw, which cost \$10, are numbered from 000 001 to 317 000. The rights for the distribution and sale of the 317,000 tickets for this draw are limited to individuals authorized by Opération Enfant Soleil. The draw is open to any person (excluding corporate entities) residing in Quebec aged 18 years and over whose first name, last name and civic address will be written on the contest entry form. It should be noted that ticket sales on the internet are limited to Quebec residents.

Winners must claim their prizes by presenting their winning ticket and confirming their identity with two (2) pieces of identification before August 17, 2020. In the event that any prizes go unclaimed, Opération Enfant Soleil will carry out a second draw on August 17, 2020, in the same order as the original draw, at its head office at 450 St-Jean-Baptiste Avenue, Office 10, Québec City, Quebec - G2E 6H5 (phone: 1-877-683-2325). The winners of this second draw will be notified by phone on the day of the draw or in the following days if they were absent at the time of the first phone call.

For the “Grand Prize,” a maximum of four (4) months must be granted to Bonneville Homes to deliver the house. Bonneville Homes will have a period of six (6) months to finish work on the site after delivery of the house. The house will be delivered between September 1, 2020 and May 15, 2021. The foundation and the excavation of the ground cannot be completed from November 1 to April 1 due to the freeze period. If the “Grand Prize” winner chooses the prize in cash, the amount of \$325,000 in cash will be given to him or her no later than 60 calendar days after the claim.

\*The actual house could differ from the picture printed on your ticket. \*If the installation and finishing of the house take place more than 250 km from the city of Belœil, \$150 per kilometre will have to be paid by the winner.
