

Passeport de rêve Air Canada 2021-2022 Rules for the Draw Benefiting Opération Enfant Soleil

The "Passeport de rêve Air Canada 2021-2022" contest organized by Opération Enfant Soleil will begin on September 1, 2021 and end on February 23, 2022.

The holder of the first ticket drawn will receive one (1) prize, hereafter referred to as the "Grand Prize," with a total value of \$87,000 and including:

- Eight (8) Business Class tickets valid for two years for any Air Canada destination, with an approximate commercial value of \$44,000;
- One million (1,000,000) Aeroplan miles, valued at \$33,000, applicable according to the Aeroplan terms and conditions outlined at www.aeroplan.com; and
- \$10,000 CAN in cash, awarded in the form of a cheque made out to the winner when they claim their prize. (Collectively, the "Air Canada Prize.") This prize is non-refundable, non-transferrable, and non-assignable.

The winner of the Grand Prize may choose between the prize valued at \$87,000 or the sum of \$25,000 CAN in cash.

The following conditions apply to the Grand Prize:

- a) The winner and their companions must have valid passports prior to the departure date. The winner must take the steps to obtain their passport themselves.
- b) The winners of an Air Canada Prize are responsible for all expenses related to fuel and insurance (including health or accident insurance), surcharges, taxes, and other applicable fees and expenses related to using a credit card when making a reservation. The winners of an Air Canada Prize and their travel companion, if applicable, remain responsible for all costs, expenses, and taxes that are not expressly outlined in the present document, including but without being limited to local accommodation taxes, ground transportation (including to and from the point of departure), gratuities, merchandise, telephone calls, personal travel insurance (if desired), personal expenses of any kind, meals and beverages, service charges and entertainment expenses, and in-flight meals. No Aeroplan points or miles or points from any other loyalty program will be granted for the trip.
- c) In the event that the winner cannot accept their prize for any reason whatsoever (for example, if the winner does not hold a valid passport), they will receive no compensation in exchange, and they will not be able to transfer their prize to another person.
- d) No changes are allowed for the reservations once the travel date is confirmed and the tickets have been issued. The trip booked with plane tickets must be completed by February 23, 2024. No blackout period applies.
- e) The Air Canada Prize must be accepted as is and can be used for products and services offered by Air Canada or its affiliated companies, as the case may be, in accordance with and subject to all relevant terms and conditions applicable at the time of exchange, including Air Canada's General Terms and Conditions of Carriage, accessible to the public at https://www.aircanada.com/ca/en/aco/home/legal/conditions-carriage-tariffs.html. Aeroplan points have no monetary value, but are redeemable according to the Aeroplan program for flights and other rewards. The retail value of the rewards received using Aeroplan points will vary according to the Aeroplan reward schedules and other factors, the details of which can be found at https://www.aircanada.com/ca/en/aco/home/aeroplan.html. Aeroplan points can only be exchanged in accordance with the general terms and conditions of the Aeroplan program. - f) A minimum of one (1) Aeroplan miles exchange transaction per year is required to keep the miles account active. Besides this condition, the miles are valid until they are fully used.
- g) The winner will be free to use the amount of \$10,000 CAN in cash that will be awarded to them by cheque however they wish—for example, on other trips.

The organizers of the draw cannot be held liable:

- a) in the event that one or more passengers are denied access to air transport by the carrier for any reason whatsoever. The same applies for entering another country or returning to Canada by either customs service. All passengers are responsible for complying with the laws and regulations of the countries visited, airports, airline, customs authorities, etc.;
- b) in the event of a last-minute impediment, whether this is due to illness, accident, or any other unforeseen event whatsoever, the organizers cannot allow the prize to be transferred to another person; and

Secondary prizes

Forty-two (42) secondary prizes will be drawn after the Grand Prize, and the holders of the winning tickets will each receive a prize according to the following order:

- The first two (2) winners will each receive a \$2,500 gift card redeemable at Meubles Léon;
- The next five (5) winners will each receive a vacation package redeemable at a Fairmont Hotel in Quebec, according to the following order:
 - o Fairmont The Queen Elizabeth, valued at \$3,286; Fairmont Le Château Frontenac, valued at \$2,209; Fairmont Le Château Montebello, valued at \$2,000; Fairmont Le Manoir Richelieu, valued at \$1,469; and Fairmont Tremblant, valued at \$1,239. - The next five (5) winners will each receive a \$1,000 gift card redeemable at Bikini Village;
- The next five (5) winners will each receive a \$1,000 gift card redeemable at Bureau en Gros;
- The next five (5) winners will each receive a \$1,000 gift card redeemable at Flordeco;
- The next 10 winners will each receive a \$500 gift card redeemable at Canada Valises Dépôt.ca; and
- The next 10 winners will each receive a \$500 gift card redeemable at Stokes.

These prizes are non-refundable, non-transferrable, non-assignable, and non-redeemable for cash. The gift cards and vacation packages must be redeemed at the respective stores and partners, according to the applicable terms and conditions of the issuer.
