How much has Opération Enfant Soleil raised for Quebec hospitals and organizations since its foundation?


Since 1988, close to \$288 million has been distributed to major paediatric centres, regional hospitals and organizations in the province.

Who receives these funds?

Donations are distributed among Quebec's four major paediatric centres:


- The CHU de Québec's Centre mère-enfant Soleil-Université Laval;
- The CHU Sainte-Justine in Montréal;
- The Montreal Children's Hospital of the CUSM;
- The CIUSSS de l'Estrie – CHUS.

In addition, close to 100 grants are given out each year to organizations and regional hospitals.



Opération Enfant Soleil is a non-profit organization that raises funds for the development of high-quality paediatrics for all the children in Quebec.

How is the money used?

The money is used by:

- Québec's major paediatric centres to equip themselves with state-of-the-art technology and facilities specially adapted for sick children;
- Regional hospitals to obtain specialized equipment, which allows children to be treated close to their families, in their own region;
- Organizations working in the fields of social and physical health to purchase specialized equipment for children.



Regions tour: your donations making the rounds!

- Children in need of medical care live all over Quebec.
- People just like you, who are concerned with the health of these children, make donations to Opération Enfant Soleil.
- Health professionals want to give these children every chance to get better. Sometimes this requires purchasing supplies and specialized equipment, or developing spaces for the reception, diagnosis and treatment of these children.
- The large paediatric centres and regional hospitals send us their financing requests for specific projects.
- A committee of independent experts made up of health professionals analyzes all requests with the aim of meeting the most urgent needs.
- More than a hundred grants are given every year from the money raised from donations like yours.

What is the Opération Enfant Soleil Telethon?



The Opération Enfant Soleil Telethon is the organization's most important fundraising activity. The total amount raised during Opération Enfant Soleil's 35th Telethon was a record sum of \$20 682 867.

The Telethon is made possible thanks to the participation of hundreds of collaborators, partners, volunteers, artists and our precious ambassadors, such as our Enfant Soleil families and hosts.

The Telethon is an emotion-filled event celebrating children where many artists give moving performances year after year.
